CoreOptics the Nuremberg based technology-start-up relocates to its new offices at the Technology Campus Nordostpark in Nuremberg

Nuremberg, Germany, July 6th, 2001: „The timing is perfect“, states Achim Herzberger, an executive of CoreOptics, „the relocation to the Technology Campus Nordostpark provides us medium term with sufficient space to keep up with the planned and necessary increase of our staff“.

At Nuremberg the R&D- center of the company is located. CoreOptics goals can only be realized with the most qualified personal: „Exactly this expert staff is available in the region. We are happy and proud to have chosen this location and believe in its future potential“ says Theo Kupfer, a CoreOptics-Founder.

Currently 30 experts work at Nordostpark 12-14 in Nuremberg und further expansion is planned for year-end. The new facilities provide besides offices also a perfect laboratory infrastructure. This is necessary for the development of high technology products that can compete on a global basis.

CoreOptics is a well-regarded German-American high-tech start-up. CoreOptics develops and manufactures modules and subsystems for telecommunications infrastructure, in particular for high-speed optical network technology. Although only founded this February CoreOptics has been able to attract very reputable international investors from three continents. Crescendo Ventures, Techno Venture Management (TVM) and Fujitsu Quantum Devices (FQD) participated in the first round in February 2001, which was one of the largest first round equity financing ever received by a start-up in Germany.
